

Texas Provisional License Checklist

- Schedule Appointment: schedule appointment in advance for your behind-the-wheel driving road test at: http://www.dps.texas.gov/DriverLicense/onlineScheduling.aspx
- Parent-Taught Instructor must accompany you to appointment
- **Driver Education Certificate (DE-964):** driver education completion certificate from Online Driving Professor
- **Texas Learner License:** show to Texas DPS before driving test
- **Social Security Card:** bring your actual social security car with you
- Verification of Enrollment and Attendance Form (VOE): obtained from your high school and signed by a school administrator, or a high school diploma or GED certificate if graduated, and home school parents may download and complete the VOE from the TDLR website at: <u>www.tdlr.texas.gov</u>
- **Valid Texas Registration and Inspection Sticker:** you must have a current Texas Registration and Inspection sticker on the vehicle used for the driving test
- **Current Proof of Liability Insurance:** current insurance card for vehicle used in driving test
- Impact Texas Teen Driver Certificate: certificate received after successfully completing the 2 hour on-line Impact Texas Teen Driver video course. The certificate must be dated within 90 days of the driving test
- Application for Texas Driver License (Form DL-14A): available online or at a Texas DPS Driver License office
- Provisional License Fee: bring \$16 payment for the Texas Provisional Driver License fee payable by cash, credit, check, or money order
- **30-Hour Driving Log:** found in Online Driving Professor's Behind-the-Wheel Packet and Behind-the-Wheel Lesson 13
